The latest version of SuperPOSS, known as SuperPOSS 2002, offers a new upgrade for all supported registers and operating system platforms:

- 5.30.05 for Windows systems
- 6.30.05 for ICL and ScanMaster systems
- 5.60.01 for UNIX systems

All the core features of SuperPOSS are still available in SuperPOSS 2002 as well as improvements to the current functionality.

Some more visible items addressed in the new release are:

1. PFM Inventory 13 digit EANS now available on the inventory report.
2. Repairs to the base product regarding the reset of register movement fields when deleting and re-adding items. Now when items are deleted and re-added, negative movement will not be generated.
3. Full availability of zero movement reporting in the sales analysis module.
4. Modifying the reorg of the plufile and velfile will be less confusing. ISAMROG changed to reorg and dropping of deleted records with no movement, instead of reorg and deletion of zero movement items for reorg of plufile and velfile.
5. Repair of EOD (End of Day) time screen to only interrupt on the ESC key instead of any key on the keyboard.

MEISolutions' PFM's extensive inventory management utilities allow you to perform a physical inventory and compare it to book, wall-to-wall inventories, or inventories divided by department and category. Ethernet and Serial communication modes are available. The PFM add-on option lets you use one or more portable entry terminals to perform shelf audits, make on the spot price changes, take inventory, perform PLU file maintenance and verify direct store deliveries.

The information collected can be immediately updated on the Point of Sale device or held for later communications. While running the network, each portable entry terminal becomes, in effect, a remote computer terminal from which you can access certain SuperPOSS functions.

The PFM runs in the background, leaving the keyboard free for:

- Price changes
- Financial reporting
- Movement reporting

## FREQUENT BUYER



**Fostering customer loyalty and attracting new business are the two most critical functions of a store's marketing campaign. MEISolutions's Frequent Buyer Program is an optional add-on module to the SuperPOSS backoffice system that addresses these issues directly.**

Frequent Buyer for NCR 2127 tracks each customer's purchases in the store, as individuals or in demographic groups. With the Frequent Buyer Program installed on your system, you can use SuperPOSS to maintain a customer file containing each customer's name, number and other pertinent information. SuperPOSS can retrieve customer transaction data during its End of Day Processing routine and use the information to provide a range of reports for managing and promoting sales at your store. The program enables you to tailor your store's operation to the specific needs and desires of your customers

A Frequent Buyer discount acts as an "electronic coupon" which is automatically applied through the register. The register receipt tape will show the customer an item's regular price as well as the amount of the Frequent Buyer savings.

Frequent Buyer lets you print customer lists and mailing labels for all your Frequent Buyer customers. In addition, you can sort by separate customer categories, such as new Frequent Buyer customers, active or inactive customers, or those whose purchases have totaled a specific minimum.

**MEISolutions' Total Savings allows you to show your customers a total of all the savings they received by shopping at your store. This program is designed for retailers who want to show a total savings amount on the customer's receipt without using frequent shopper cards. The Total Savings module provides the ability to add savings information printed on a customer's receipt with a special program on the register.**

When you put an item on AD/sale, TPR, or Manager Special, the Total Savings module calculates the difference between the regular price and the sale price, then clearly displays the sum of these savings on the customer's receipt.

MEISolutions' Total Savings module interfaces with the Simple Savings program for NCR 2127 systems; with the You Saved application for Scanmaster users; and with the Total Savings component of the ICL ISS45 system.

- Clear alternate price on all items
- Clear all items with expired hold date  
(Inactive ad/sale, TPR, or Manager Special)
- Clear all items without hold dates
